



## **I SEMINÁRIO INTERNACIONAL DE PESQUISAS EM ENSINO E APRENDIZAGEM DE LÍNGUAS: ABORDAGENS QUANTITATIVA E MISTA**

### **1st International Seminar on Research in Language Teaching and Learning: Quantitative and mixed approaches**

**Dates: November 10th to 12th, 2021**

The Universidade Federal do Pampa's research group "Teaching and Learning languages: a quantitative approach" promotes the 1st International Seminar in Language in Teaching and Learning: quantitative and mixed approaches. This free event is going to be online on November 10th, 11th and 12th. It aims to promote scientific research in the teaching and learning of languages focused on different teaching contexts and diverse methodological and theoretical perspectives. The researchers need to privilege quanti-qualitative, quali-quantitative or only quantitative approaches.

The main theme of the 1st International Seminar in Language in Teaching and Learning: Quantitative and mixed approaches is "multiple research approaches" as we encourage the promotion of research that somehow privileges the quantitative approach as a central focus or as a complement to the qualitative approach.

**The event's organization through the theme "multiple research approaches" aims to:**

- Promote the exchange of experiences between researchers and students from national and international higher education institutions about what has been developed in those institutions related to the quantitative and mixed approaches.
- Encourage discussions about themes and methodological procedures that have been relevant to language studies on the world stage.
- Foster dialogue between language researchers in order to assure exchanges of knowledges and experiences about the teaching of the mother tongue and

additional/foreign languages.

- Provide formative space to researchers interested in instrumentalizing themselves in quantitative and mixed studies methods in the teaching and learning of languages.

### **About submitting proposals to the Thematic Symposium:**

According to the submission of proposals to the Thematic Symposium norms. The proposals need to include the following:

- a) It will be accepted academic studies and researches that are related to the following thematic axes:
  - (i) The Teaching and Learning of Languages and Literature;
  - (ii) New technologies in the Teaching and Learning of Languages and Literature;
  - (iii) Language studies in different contexts.
- b) All the participants who want to propose thematic symposiums need to send an abstract indicating the thematic axe that the symposium will be related to by e-mail to the organizing committee from July 5th to July 26th. - c) The proposal to the thematic symposium can be up to two authors.
- d) The abstract must be between 200 and 300 words. It is not necessary to include the bibliographical references.
- e) The abstract must have the following elements: title, theme, aim, theoretical framework, research *corpus* (if necessary), methodological procedures and possible/main results or pedagogical implications.
- f) In the end of the abstract, there must be three to five keywords preceded by the expression “keyword”, separated by colon and ended with full stop, with the same font and size used in the abstract.

The list of approved proposals for the thematic symposiums will be published on the event’s page until August 8th.

#### **About submitting papers to the Thematic Symposium:**

- a) Research and academic studies will be accepted.
- b) All the participants who want to present their studies in the thematic symposiums must **send the abstract by e-mail to the Symposium Coordinator, from August 15th to September 15th. Check the list of symposiums with the name and contact details of the coordinator in the next circular letter.**
- c) The study can have up to five authors.
- d) The abstract must be between **200 and 300 words**. It is not necessary to include the bibliographical references.
- e) The abstract must have the following elements: title, theme, aim, theoretical framework, research *corpus* (if necessary), methodological procedures and possible/main results or pedagogical implications.
- f) In the end of the abstract, there must be three to five keywords preceded by the expression “keywords”, separated by period and ended with a period, with the same font and size used in the abstract.
- g) The presence online of at least one of the authors is required to the presentation.
- h) All authors and co-authors included in the research must register for the event after acceptance to confirm their presentation.
- i) Only those who present their research, on an online platform, will receive certificates according to the event program.
- j) The evaluation and selection of papers will be carried out by the Scientific Committee of the event.
- k) Each accepted paper has to be presented within a maximum of 15 minutes, on the Google Meet platform. The access to the platform will be via a link to be published later. All thematic symposia will take place in the afternoon and evening shifts, from the 10th to the 12th of November.

The authors will receive by e-mail an acceptance letter until 10/10/2021

Note: Abstracts that do not follow the standards will not be submitted to the Scientific Committee.

4. Acceptance letters/e-mails to the abstracts submitted to the Thematic Symposiums - Until October 10th
